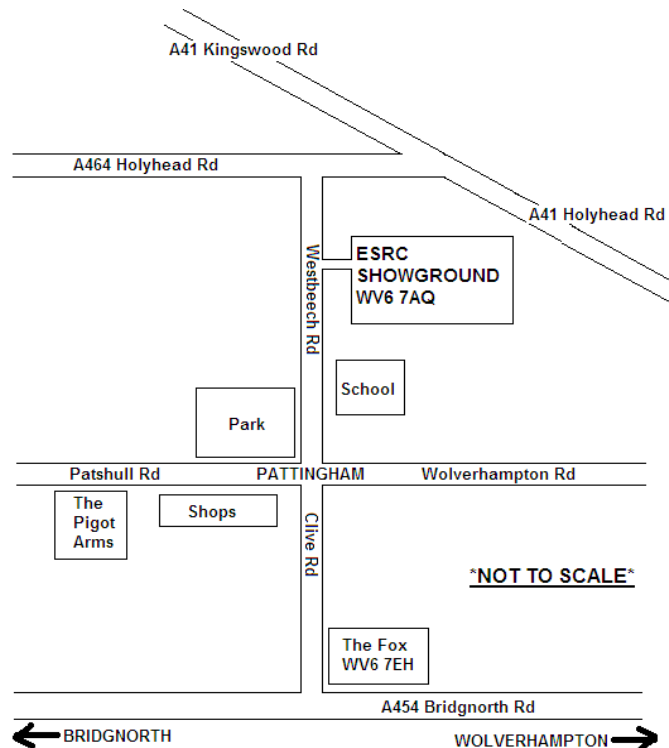


## RULES

1. Neither organisers nor any person acting on their behalf accept any liability for loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horse, competitors, spectators or any person or property whatsoever.
2. The organisers of the event have taken all precautions necessary to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all official stewards.
3. Dressage competitions run under British Dressage rules, Show jumping based upon British Showjumping rules and showing in line with relevant Show Society.
4. Judges' decision is final.
5. Body protectors are advised for Show jumping competitions and jackets are compulsory.
6. Latest standards in hard hats as defined by BRC (see website for details) and smooth soled footwear with a heel must both be worn by riders at all times whilst mounted.
7. Show organisers reserve the right to cancel an event, amend or amalgamate any class and refuse any entry.
8. Any objections must be brought to the organisers attention within 48 hours of the incident and be supported by the complaint in writing and a £20 deposit, which will be refunded if the objection stands

## Welcome to ESRC Open Show

All classes are open to members, non - members and juniors, with rosettes to 6<sup>th</sup> place and a trophy/voucher to the overall winner. Juniors and seniors will be judged separately in all classes dependent upon entries. All classes are qualifiers for **MIDARC**. Selected classes qualify for **ROR Riding Club Challenge** and **BRC Grass Roots Points League** (latter for RC members only). See individual discipline pages for details of which classes qualify. Class Awards will be presented at the end of the year to the competitor attaining the most points in each class, and trophies for the most points gained throughout the season in each discipline. In addition, Annual Challenge Trophies awarded to the highest placed ESRC member in each discipline. Eight points awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> place down to three points for 6<sup>th</sup> place, with one point awarded if unplaced. You must have attended minimum of two shows to be considered for end of season awards, and provide your contact details to the Entries caravan. Entries taken on the day with the exception of Dressage. Dressage pre-entries and payments must be received prior to taking the test.

#### **CHANGES/NEW for 2017:**

**Any horse/pony and rider combination that has achieved 65% more than twice at prelim level or above before 1<sup>st</sup> May 2017 is not allowed to enter classes 1 & 2 competitively (H.C. allowed).**

**\*Class 2 is only open to riders under the age of 18 as of 1<sup>st</sup> January 2017**

**ALL classes qualify for BRC Grass Roots Points League (RC members only). All classes qualify for ROR Riding Club Challenge points.**

ENTRIES must be received by the Wednesday prior to the Sunday of the show. Times will be available on the Friday before the show on the website from 7pm onwards. Payment for the class must be received at the entries caravan before the competitor enters the ring.

If you cannot compete for any reason you will still have to pay for your entry if you have not withdrawn before the dressage times are published. Anyone who abuses this will not be allowed to enter future ESRC dressage classes. The competition is reliant on competitor's honesty when entering classes. Any discovery of dishonesty will result in immediate elimination.

Open to any combination of horse/pony and rider not placed 1<sup>st</sup> in any show jumping competition before 1<sup>st</sup> May 2017. Lead rein welcome. No solid fillers. Overall winner is awarded one hours' free use of the indoor or outdoor arena at, and courtesy of, The Mill Riding Centre.
