
RULES

- 1. Neither organisers nor any person acting on their behalf accept any liability for loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horse, competitors, spectators or any person or property whatsoever.
- The organisers of the event have taken all precautions necessary to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all official stewards.
- 3. Dressage competitions run under BD Dressage rules, Show jumping based upon BSJA rules and showing in line with relevant show society.
- 4. Judges' decision is final.
- 5. Body protectors are advised for Show jumping competitions and jackets are compulsory.
- 6. Hard hats to PAS015 on EN1384 and smooth soled footwear with a heel must be worn by riders at all times whilst mounted.
- 7. Show organisers reserve the right to cancel an event, amend or amalgamate any class and refuse any entry.
- 8. Any objections must be brought to the organisers attention within 48 hours of the incident and be supported by the complaint in writing and a £20 deposit, which will be refunded if the objection stands

Welcome to ESRC Open Show

All classes are open to members, non - members and juniors, with rosettes to 6th place and a trophy/voucher to the overall winner. Juniors and seniors will be judged separately in all classes dependent upon entries. Awards will be presented at the end of the year to the competitor attaining the most points in each class, and trophies for the most points gained throughout the season in each discipline. Annual Challenge Trophies awarded to the highest placed *ESRC member* in each discipline. Six points awarded for 1st place down to one point for 6th place. You must have attended minimum of two shows to be considered for end of season awards, and we will need your contact details to be left at the Entries caravan on Show Days. Entries taken on the day with the exception of Dressage. Dressage preentries and payments must be received prior to show date.

RESTRICTED & OPEN SECTIONS IN CLASSES 1, 3, 4 & 5

Any horse and rider combination that hasn't achieved 65% twice at the class level before 1st April 2015 is restricted. Any horse and rider combination that has scored over 65% 2 times or more before 1st April 2015 must then be open level. Any horse that has BD, BE points or is registered may only compete as open.

PRIX CAPRILLI tests are basically Walk & Trot dressage tests with a few jumps in! Jumps do not exceed 2ft3. The test is marked as a dressage test and extra marks will be given for gait and style when jumping. Penalties are also given for a knock down or refusal. The tests will be available to download from our website one month before each show, or email us to request one.

ENTRIES

Entries must be received by the Wednesday prior to the Sunday of the show. Payment must be received before the competitor enters the ring. If you cannot compete for any reason you will still have to pay for your entry if you have not withdrawn before the times are published. Anyone who abuses this will not be allowed to enter future ESRC events.

*Please state whether you are open or restricted when entering.
